## Offline Storage Facility and Standby Pump System

### Project Update:

Welcome to our first Neighbour's Update of 2018 – we hope you had a lovely Christmas and New Year and wish you a happy and successful year ahead!

Works recommenced at the Offline Water Facility Site on the 8<sup>th</sup> January, after a two-week shutdown over the Christmas period.

Construction on the spillway is now complete, with the main embankment to be completed by the end of the month. At that point, the construction focus will turn the pump station, located adjacent to Cupitt Road. Several large components will be mobilised onto site during the months April to May 2018, which may cause some minor delays to those neighbours who utilise Skyhill Ring Road and Cupitt Road.

The upgrade of Cupitt Road will also commence mid-March and we will discuss any expected delays directly with those neighbours affected.

In the coming months, GAWB will design and construct a small lookout, located on the northern side of the storage. The lookout will be accessible by foot only, with a parking area constructed at the end of Cupitt Road.
