New board member appointed by Gladstone Area Water Board

The Queensland Government has appointed Councillor (Cr) Kahn Goodluck as a Director to the Board of Gladstone Area Water Board (GAWB), commencing 8 August 2024.

Cr Goodluck replaces outgoing Board member Peter Masters. As a current councillor with Gladstone Regional Council, Cr Goodluck brings a wealth of experience regarding the local community and the wider Gladstone region.

Gladstone Area Water Board Chair, Ms Adrienne Ward, thanked Peter for his years of service to the board.

In accordance with the Water Act 2003 (QLD), Directors are appointed for a term of three years. The continuing members of the GAWB Board are Ms Suzanne Burow, Mr Mitchell Petrie and Ms Tina Zawila.

Gladstone Area Water Board, as a Queensland Government Bulk Water Supply Authority, delivers safe and reliable water services which promote economic development and enhances the lifestyle of regional Queensland. Gladstone Area Water Board owns and operates Awoonga Dam on the Boyne River, along with a network of delivery pipelines, water treatment plants and other bulk water distribution infrastructure.

To ensure long-term water security for customers, the 117-kilometre Fitzroy to Gladstone Pipeline project is under development. When delivered, the pipeline will form part of the Gladstone Area Water Board network and provide enhanced water security and reliability for the region.
